

# Downloading eBooks to your Amazon Kindle® Device

1. Go to [www.hmpl.org](http://www.hmpl.org).
2. Click “Downloadable Books” on the right side (If you have a Herrick Library Card you will have go through their website).
3. Use the website’s searching options to find an eBook in Kindle format.

## **Searching Options** (Located on the left side of the screen)

**Quick Search** — in the “Quick Search” box type in keywords such as a subject, author, title or any combination of words. Click “Show available copies” for books available for immediate download.

**Advanced Search** — with this search option you are able search for eBooks in a particular format (i.e. Kindle)

**Browse** — choose your eBooks from subject categories located on the menu on the left side of the screen.

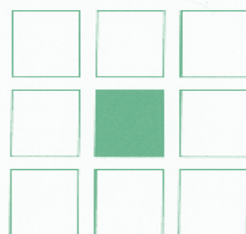
4. From your search results, select a title available in the Kindle format and click on “Add to Cart”.
5. To checkout click “Proceed to Checkout”.
6. Enter your library card number (without spaces).
7. Choose a lending period (7 or 14 days) and click “Confirm Checkout”
7. Click “Get for Kindle” button, which will take you to Amazon’s web page.
8. Click “Get Library Book” on the upper right side.
9. Sign in to your Amazon account using your email address and password. If you do not have an Amazon account you can create one from this page.
10. Click the arrow buttons to the right of “Deliver To”, select your Kindle device from the drop down menu, and click the “Continue” button.
11. A message will display indicating your library eBook has been delivered to your device.

**NOTE:** If you do NOT sync your Kindle device wirelessly (through Wi-Fi access) then you will need to click the “Download now” to sync your device using a USB cable connect to your computer.

12. Your library eBook will be available the next time your device is synced with your amazon account using a wireless (Wi-Fi ) connection.
13. You will receive an email from Amazon when you have 3 days left of your title and also when the title has expired.
14. To manage your digital titles go to “Manage Your Kindle” section of your Amazon account.
